

TCL Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by Gary Olive.

Approval of Minutes

The first item of business was the approval of the minutes of the January 8, 2008 Meeting. Upon motion duly made and seconded, the minutes were unanimously approved.

Officers' Reports

The next item of business was the presentation of the Officer's Reports, as follows:

- Treasurer Report – Maurice Coreil provided a brief Treasurer's report. He reported that the final numbers for the Challengefest tournament appear to be around \$23,345, which is still very good. He also reported that he still has bond monies for three teams that he needs to return. Finally, he indicated that one team, U-18 GUS Blast, has not yet turned in its bond money for the Spring season.
- Younger Boys Commissioner – Robert Oliver reported that there were no issues to report.
- Younger Girls Commissioner – Kim Kerns was not able to attend.
- Older Boys & Girls Commissioner – Ricky Cooper indicated that there was nothing to report.
- D&A – Tom Cartee was unable to attend.

Old Business

The items of old business covered at the meeting were as follows:

TCL Clinic – Dave Clark gave a brief report on the TCL Clinic recently held at Glenn HS. He reported that it was the lowest turnout that the clinic had attracted in many years. This year's clinic had approximately 76 people attend, while last year's clinic had around 120. Significant discussion then ensued regarding how to improve attendance at this clinic. Dave asked for folks to consider volunteering next year on the planning committee to see if some new ideas could be generated for improving attendance. Maurice Coreil volunteered to help serve on that committee.

New Business

- **Proposal for Older Girls to Play in Spring** – Monty Griffith submitted a proposal on behalf of one of the ICRD coaches wishing to see TCL offer Spring season play to U-15 through U-19 girls teams wanting to play. A limited discussion then ensued. It was pointed out that this, in fact, had been tried before, but that the league was never able to get enough teams interested in playing to make it work. No formal action was taken on this proposal. The consensus seemed to be that no one was opposed to allowing the older girls to play in the Spring, and this could be addressed next year if enough teams indicated a desire to play.
