The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by Garry Norman.

**Approval of Minutes**

The first item of business was the approval of the minutes of the November 6, 2007 Meeting. Upon motion duly made and seconded, the minutes were unanimously approved.

**Officers' Reports**

The next item of business was the presentation of the Officer's Reports, as follows:

- Treasurer Report – Maurice Coreil indicated that there was no formal treasurer's report. He also stated that the tax return will be filed shortly. He also stated that there were a few more checks coming in from Challengefest. It looks like TCL will make about \$25,000 in profit from that tournament which he felt was really quite good given the smaller number of teams that signed up as compared to last year.
- Younger Boys Commissioner – Robert Oliver reported that there were several younger boys games scheduled for the Fall did not get played; otherwise there were no issues to report.
- Younger Girls Commissioner – Kim Kerns was not able to attend.
- Older Boys & Girls Commissioner – Ricky Cooper indicated that there was nothing to report.

## **Old Business**

The items of old business covered at the meeting were as follows:

- **Spring 2008 Intents to Play and Spring Bond Money.** Garry Norman noted that the intents and bond monies were now due and that Demp would be accepting them at the end of the meeting.
- **TCL Clinic.** Dave Clark then discussed the upcoming TCL Clinic to be held on February 2, 2008 at Glenn High School. He encouraged everyone to come. Garry Norman briefly went over some of the proposed presenters at the clinic.

## **New Business**

- It was reported that at the Challenge Council Meeting, held on December 1, 2007, the motion to bring back the offside rule at the U10 level was rejected. Garry also noted that there was a discussion regarding the proper level of pay for single referees for U10 games. It was announced that the rate of pay for a single referee should be \$28.00 per game maximum. It was also stressed that the “no pass – no play” rule would be enforced. Teams must have player cards for each player; any players without cards will not be allowed to play.
